

General Guidelines

We want Taptot to be a fun, easy, safe and friendly online platform to share for our users. Help us foster this young community. Post only your own resources and always follow the law. Respect everyone on Taptot, don't spam people or post inappropriate pictures/language.

Taptot is a venue to cultivate the act of giving, and sharing. We've spent a lot of time thinking from different point of views to create a safe and open environment for everyone.

We created these General Guidelines so you can help us foster and protect this amazing community. By using Taptot, you agree to these guidelines, our Terms of Use and Privacy Policy. We're committed to these guidelines and we hope you are too. Overstepping these boundaries may result in deleted content, disabled accounts, or other restrictions.

- **Post only photos and videos of your own resources that you've taken or have the right to share.** You must own the content you post on Taptot. Remember to post authentic content, and don't post anything you've copied or collected from the Internet that you don't have the right to give or share.
- **Post photos and videos that are appropriate for a diverse audience.** We know that there are times when people might want to share nude images that are artistic or creative in nature, but for a variety of reasons, we don't allow nudity on Taptot. This includes photos, videos, and some digitally-created content that show sexual intercourse, genitals, and close-ups of fully-nude buttocks. It also includes some photos of female nipples. Nudity in photos of paintings and sculptures is OK. For safety reasons, there are times when we may remove images deemed inappropriate for children. Even when this content is shared with good intentions, it could be misinterpreted by others in unanticipated ways.
- **Foster meaningful and genuine interactions.** Help us stay spam-free by not artificially collecting likes, followers, or shares, posting repetitive comments or content, or repeatedly contacting people for commercial purposes without their consent.
- **Follow the law.** Taptot is not a place to support or praise terrorism, organized crime, or hate groups. Offering sexual services, buying, selling or giving firearms and illegal or prescription drugs (even if it's legal in your region) is also not allowed. Remember to always follow the law when offering to give, share and designate other regulated goods. Accounts promoting online gambling, online real money games of skill or online lotteries are not allowed. We have zero tolerance when it comes to sharing sexual content involving minors or threatening to post intimate images of others.
- **Respect other members of the Taptot community.** We want to foster a positive, diverse community. We remove content that contains credible threats or hate speech, content that targets private individuals to degrade or shame them,

personal information meant to blackmail or harass someone, and repeated unwanted messages. We do generally allow stronger conversation around people who are featured in the news or have a large public audience due to their profession or chosen activities. It's never OK to encourage violence or attack anyone based on their race, ethnicity, national origin, sex, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, religious affiliation, disabilities, or diseases. Serious threats of harm to public and personal safety aren't allowed. This includes specific threats of physical harm as well as threats of theft, vandalism, and other financial harm. We carefully review reports of threats and consider many things when determining whether a threat is credible.

- **Maintain our supportive environment by not glorifying self-injury.** The Taptot community cares for each other, encouraging or urging people to embrace self-injury is counter to this environment of support, and we'll remove it or disable accounts if it's reported to us. We may also remove content identifying victims or survivors of self-injury if the content targets them for attack or humor.
- **Be thoughtful when posting images involving violence.** Because so many different people and age groups use Taptot, we may remove videos of intense, graphic violence to make sure Taptot stays appropriate for everyone. If you do share content involving violence, we encourage you to caption your photo with a warning about graphic violence. Sharing graphic images for sadistic pleasure or to glorify violence is never allowed.
- **User Guidelines:**
 1. Please take clear photos with clean background to accurately reveal your giveaways.
 2. Accurately categorize your giveaway would help others find your post and increase the chance to give it away.
 3. Make sure to specify expiration dates for time sensitive giveaways and make sure to remove them as they get expired.
 4. Please be explicit in describing your giveaway's features, conditions, and flaws. Do not use photos of new products for used items to prevent misunderstandings.
 5. It is highly recommended that you share giveaways that are worth taking to increase the chance to give it away.
 6. Please make sure you input the right weight when posting, otherwise we would charge any additional shipping fees incurred due to inaccurate package weight.
 7. Please make sure you fill out your real name and complete address to avoid shipping exceptions.
 8. Make sure you select a pick-up date/drop off date within 24hours to avoid auto cancellation and to avoid negative feedback from Taker.
 9. All Meet Up transactions should be completed through actual face to face sharing.
 10. Properly share all giveaways through the shipping methods provided by the platform, Taptot would not accept any claims from any other means of delivery method.
 11. If you have any inquiries regarding any giveaway, make sure you ask the giver before taking, to avoid any misunderstanding or unpleasant experiences.
 12. Please respect giver's choice of delivery method, and do not pressure giver to provide other means of delivery method.

Help us keep the community strong:

- Each of us is an important part of the Taptot community. If you see something that you think may violate our guidelines, please help us by using our built-in reporting options below:

Reporting a mal-practicing user: We take your giving and sharing experiences very seriously to ensure user satisfaction, thus if you are cheated somehow in a transaction, or see any account user doing bad things on Taptot, please let us know immediately. You may report an abusive user by following these steps:

1. Tap into the abusive user's profile picture to enter his/her user's profile page
2. Tap the "Report" icon (on the top right corner)
3. Select a corresponding option
4. Or tap "Other" to provide us as much relevant information as possible.
5. Tap Next to select a corresponding option
6. Tap Report button (at the bottom) to submit your report

Reporting a prohibited post: Whenever you see an inappropriate giveaway, or prohibited giveaway post please don't hesitate to let us know. A "Report" icon is placed in every post for your convenience to report a prohibited giveaway item. Please follow these steps to report:

1. Tap into the prohibited giveaway post
2. Tap the "Report" icon (on the top right corner)
3. Select a corresponding option
4. Or tap "Other" to provide us as much relevant information as possible.
5. Tap Next to select a corresponding option
6. Tap Report button (at the bottom) to submit your report

We have a global team that reviews these reports and works as quickly as possible to remove content that doesn't meet our guidelines. When you complete the report, try to provide as much information as possible, such as links, usernames, and descriptions of the content, so we can find and review it quickly. We may remove entire posts if either the imagery or associated captions violate our guidelines.

- You may find content you don't like, but doesn't violate the General Guidelines. If that happens, you can unfollow or block the person who posted it. If there's something you don't like in a comment on one of your posts, you can delete that comment.
- Many disputes and misunderstandings can be resolved directly between members of the community. If one of your resource or giveaways was posted by someone else, you could try commenting on the post and asking the person to take it down. If that doesn't work, you can file a copyright report. If you believe someone is violating your trademark, you can file a trademark report. Don't

target the person who posted it by posting screenshots and drawing attention to the situation because that may be classified as harassment.

- We may work with law enforcement, including when we believe that there's risk of physical harm or threat to public safety.
